Day before blood test couldn't walk due to pain in right leg, had to use crutches

16/1/25 22:00 sudden muscle ache in left leg followed by pain in right knee, left ankle and swollen hands, tight wrists. 2x paracetamol taken. Onset headache

23:19 weakness in hands sore right side of neck almost like a burning rash. Both hips. Upper arm pain left

17/1/25 from 8:40 dull ache and throbbing in thigh, right knee and right ankle pain, left knee and ankle pain. Itchy skin whole front of neck. Tight feeling in hands

9pm - pain in right thumb, ache in left arm above elbow. Still dull ache pain in right knee (lower area) headache

18/1 from 1:30 throbbing fingertips, swollen fingers

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



Calculating the WPI score

Use this checklist to calculate the widespread pain index (WPI) score. Tick the areas where you have had chronic pain for 3 months or longer.

Region 1: left upper

- L jaw
- L shoulder girdle
- L upper arm
- L lower arm and/or L wrist/hand, L elbow

Region 2: right upper

- R jaw
- R shoulder girdle
- R upper arm
- R lower arm and/or R wrist/hand, R elbow

Region 3: left lower

- L hip and/or L buttock
- L upper leg and/or L groin
- L lower leg and/or L ankle/foot, L knee

Region 4: right lower

- R hip and/or R buttock
- R upper leg and/or R groin
- R lower leg and/or R ankle/foot, R knee

Region 5: axial

- Neck
- Upper back
- Lower back
- Chest (L and/or R)
- Abdomen

Total score† for the WPI _____

†The total will be between 0 and 19.

L=left; R=right

A diagnosis requires widespread pain >3 months duration with currently either
 i) widespread pain index (WPI) ≥ 7 and symptom severity scale (SSS) score ≥ 5 , or
 ii) WPI 4–6 and SSS score ≥ 9 , with pain in 4/5 body regions (see text).
